Women Enrichment Ministries

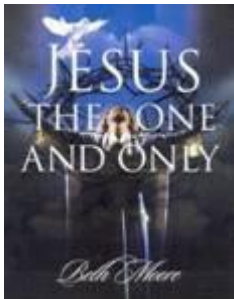

Beth Moore - JESUS THE ONE AND ONLY –starts Sept. 12, Sunday 5PM–7PM

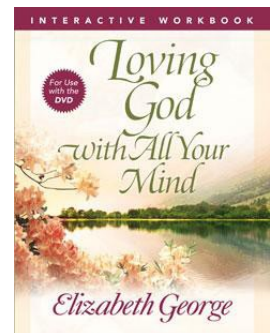

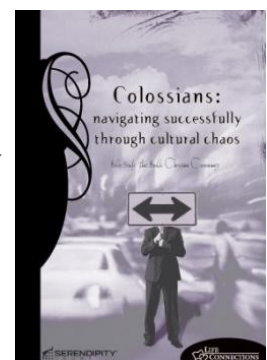
Women’s Well Bible Study - Colossians - Navigating Successfully Through Cultural Chaos

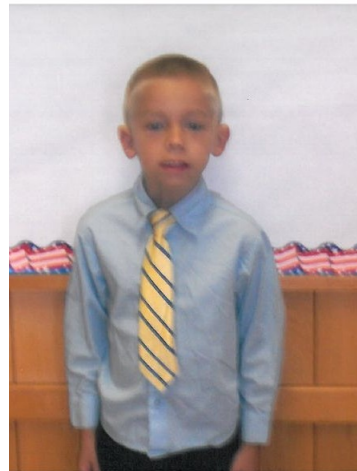
